1. The <u>NPAT 2021</u> Question Paper consists of 3 sections. All sections are having objective type questions as follows:

- 2. The 3 sections are independent sections. Candidates will not be able to progress from one section to the next section until they complete and submit their responses for the current section. Once they complete the section they will be able to go the next section on pressing the "submit" button.
- 3. The overall duration of test is 100 minutes. Candidates should keep track of the time spent through the timer provided on the screen. (Additional 6 minutes are added. 3 minutes before the start of Assessment and 3 minutes after the submission of last Quantitative & Numerical Ability section. This is to showcase Notepad/Rough Sheets in front of Webcam)
- 4. Candidates who have registered as PwD candidate, will get 20 minutes per hour extra time as per valid type of disability. Only registered candidates will get this extra time.
- 5. Candidates will have to attempt sections in sequential manner only.
- 6. Candidates will not be able to re-visit the sections once they submit their responses and come out from the section.
- 7. Once the last section is submitted the test will be submitted.
- 8. There will be **NO** negative marking
- 9. Questions will be available in English only.
- 10. Questions will be displayed on the screen one at a time.
- 11. Each question is a Multiple Choice single select Question (MCQ). It will have 4 alternatives, out of which only one is the correct answer. Candidate is expected to choose the most appropriate of the alternatives provided in alignment with the context of the question.
